

# Hanging Waterer

This cleverly designed waterer is great at providing water while limiting spillage. It also features a secure connecting system, but the downside of this is that it requires some effort to put it together. Here are some tips to assist with this process.

**1)** The waterer arrives in two pieces. A white tower and an orange base. **There is a learning curve, so we recommend that you assemble and take apart the waterer a few times before filling it with water.**

**2)** To assemble, first push up repeatedly on the orange tab so that these do not hinder the assembly process. Next, put the orange base onto the white tower and position the white ridges into the notched area on the orange piece (this should be next to the tab that was just pre-stretched).



**3)** With a secure grip on both pieces, rotate the white piece counterclockwise and the orange clockwise until the two pieces lock together. To remove, twist the pieces in the opposite directions while lightly pulling them apart.



**Repeat this a few more times and the waterer should be easier to use for the rest of its useful life.**

**4)** Now, proceed to fill the white tower to the desired water level. Next, place the orange piece onto the white tower while it is still "upside down". Twist the pieces into "locking" position. Go outside or over a sink and flip the waterer to the upward position (there may be some water spillage).

**5)** You can now set your waterer on flat ground or hang it from the loop on top of the white tower to begin providing your birds with water.
