

MIX AND FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS—FARM FLOCKS

To reconstitute, mix 1 level measuring cup* (4 oz) of dry powder with 1/2 pint of hot water (140° F), then add 1/2 pint of cold water (60° F) to cool to 100° F. Stir until product is in solution. Feed as recommended on the chart below. ***Cup in each bag holds approx. 4 oz dry weight.**

Age of Lambs (Days)	No. of Feedings per Day	Amount of Reconstituted Product per Feeding (Colostrum Milk)
1 - 3	Free Choice	
4 - 10*	4	8 oz
11 - 18	3	12 oz
19 - 42**	2	16 oz

* A good quality grain mix and water should be offered free choice after lambs reach about one (1) week of age.

** Good quality roughage should be offered free choice when lambs reach three (3) weeks of age.

LARGE FLOCKS (to 3000 head)

With mechanical mixer, reconstitute 2 lb Super Lamb Milk Replacer with 1/2 gallon hot water (140° F), then add 1/2 gallon of cold water (60° F) to cool to 100° F. Feed free choice with an automatic system.
