

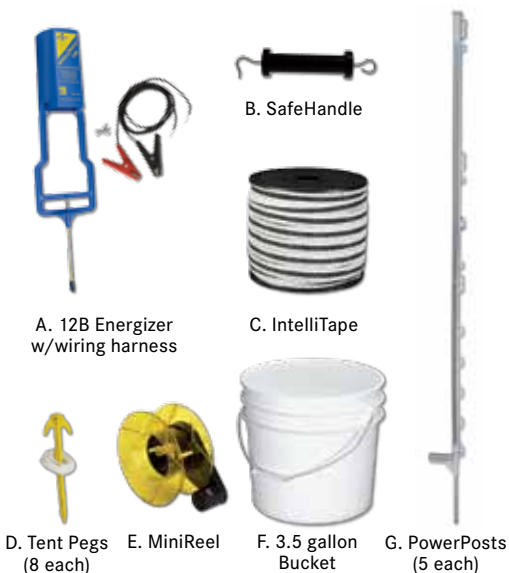

## Kit components

A ready-to-go portable package. Includes everything needed to enclose horses for short periods. The bucket is useful to keep the small parts in one place and for water or grain.

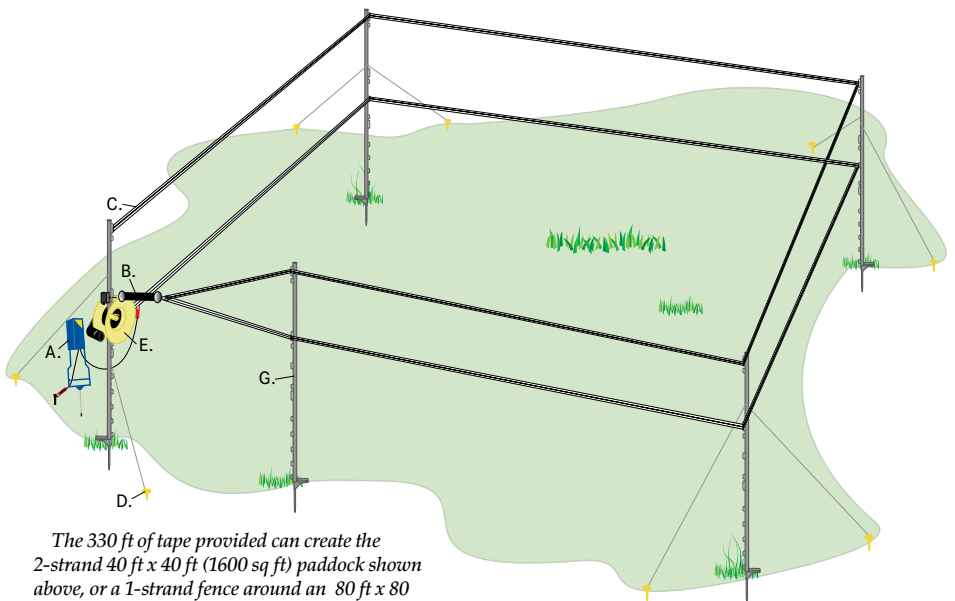

### Optional Items:

- Add'l paddock (does not include energizer).....#117802
- Extra tent pegs .....#200400
- Extra PowerPosts, 48 in.....#320830

*Overview of a trailer paddock in place with double strands of tape. All 4 sides in this pen are 40 ft long. The double strands come together into one at the gate handle, which is spring-loaded to provide tension. Posts pictured in photo (now gray) are pushed into the ground and tied back to tent pegs with white nylon rope (included in the package).*



*The 330 ft of tape provided can create the 2-strand 40 ft x 40 ft (1600 sq ft) paddock shown above, or a 1-strand fence around an 80 ft x 80 ft paddock. (You will need to purchase 4 extra posts if you wish to make the larger paddock.)*

## To install

**Tools:** A hammer to drive the tent pegs at each corner.

**Time:** 15 minutes.

The tape, when tensioned, will pull all 4 corner posts toward the center of the pen. So when installing the corner posts, tie them back just a bit toward the tent

pegs. Then string and tension the tape. The posts are not stiff enough to resist the strain without the extra support of light nonconductive rope secured to the tent pegs.

After the tape is in place and tensioned, the tieback ropes to the tent pegs will need to be adjusted to keep the posts vertical. Extra tent pegs are always useful for additional support.
