
Egg Stamps

For best results—follow these instructions:

- 1. Before you stamp your first egg, make a few imprints on a napkin or ink absorbing paper.
- 2. Use on fresh eggs only (not cooked).
- Do not use a lot of pressure when stamping the egg. Press quick and soft. The stamp should only touch the egg for a split second.
- Make sure the egg is completely dry. No moisture or condensation. Ink will bleed if egg is wet.

How to refill your egg stamp

- 1. Pull off handle from stamp base.
- Remove cap (long white portion) from the ink refill container and cut of end.
- Insert the ink refill into the hole at the top of the stamp base and squeeze to refill stamp.
- 4. Replace handle onto stamp base.
